ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that 512 Rhode Island Avenue, LLC, t/a Grapes n' Hopes Market, located at 512 Rhode Island Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C., has failed to pay the second year license fees for its License No. ABRA-077268 a Retailer's Class B License. Specifically, the Licensee failed to make the second year payment for its license by September 30, 2012, the deadline for all Retailer's B licenses, despite being notified of the payment date.

On October 24, 2012, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against 512 Rhode Island Avenue, LLC, t/a Grapes n' Hopes Market, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to pay the second year license fees for the Retailer's Class B License.




