ORDER GRANTING APPLICANT'S REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by New York Ave Beach Bar, LLC, t/a Halftime Sports Bar, for a new Retailer's Class CR License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on March 31, 2014, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On March 31, 2014, the Board dismissed the Application, because the Applicant failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. *See* Board Order No. 2014-114.

On April 8, 2014, Karl Graham, on behalf of the Applicant, filed a request for reinstatement indicating that he failed to attend the Roll Call Hearing, because he was misinformed that his appearance was not required at the Roll Call Hearing.

Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Application, the Board finds that Mr. Graham explanation constitutes good cause to reinstate the Application pursuant to 23 DCMR 1602.3.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b).
