ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Heritage management Serrvice, LLC, t/a Heritage India Brassiere & Lounge, (Respondent), has failed to renew its License No. ABRA-075074, a Retailer's Class CR license. Specifically, the Respondent failed to renew its license by March 31, 2013, the deadline for all Retailer's Class CR licenses, despite being notified of the renewal date.

On May 1, 2013, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against Heritage management Serrvice, LLC, t/a Heritage India Brassiere & Lounge, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to renew its Retailer's Class CR License.

It was determined that the Respondent is out of business when ABRA's Enforcement Division was unsuccessful serving the Order to Cease and Desist.




