3 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So what I'm going  
4 to call now, another protest status hearing Case No.  
5 12-PRO- 00034. And that's Oasis Market at 1179 3rd  
6 Street, N.E., License No. 88531 and ANC 6C.

7 MR. DIETZ: Good morning.

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Good morning.

9 MR. DIETZ: Bernard C. Dietz representing the  
10 Licensee. I have with me Ms. Eun Hi Park, who's the  
11 president of the corporation --

12 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

13 MR. DIETZ: -- And Mr. SJ Shin, who is the  
14 co- counsel.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay, good. And, sir,  
16 could you identify yourself?

17 MR. BHABHRAWALA: Good morning, Madam Chair.  
18 My name is Salim Bhabhrawala, spelled S-A-L-I-M. Last  
19 name is B-H-A-B-H-R-A-W-A-L-A. And I represent the  
20 protestants in this proceeding.

21 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So unless you all  
22 have anything to tell the Board, I'm going to just be

1 scheduling this for protest hearing on August 15th at  
2 4:00 p.m. Is there anything the Board needs to know  
3 otherwise or any problems or questions?

4 Okay. I'm not hearing any. Okay? All  
5 right. So I -- and I'll just read you some instructions  
6 regarding a protest hearing. You --

7 MR. DIETZ: Please --

8 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Yes, sir.

9 MR. DIETZ: Although my client wishes to  
10 address the Board about some concerns she has regarding  
11 this protest. She has been subjected to harassing  
12 activities by the protestants and she wishes that they  
13 would refrain from coming into the store for those  
14 purposes and allow the investigative staff to do its  
15 own investigation.

16 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

17 MR. BHABHRAWALA: Madam Chair, we don't have  
18 a problem with that. However, as is anything with a  
19 citizen that lives in a community, if somebody is  
20 breaking the law in any way, shape or form, a community  
21 member has the right to identify where that situation  
22 is and whether or not that's disrupting somebody else's

1 life. And, you know, we -- no protestant will go into  
2 the store, nor would we.

3 But when cars are illegally parked, we do ask  
4 that people do move those cars. And we're sorry that  
5 that's disruptive to the business but it's also  
6 disruptive to the lives of the people in the community.  
7 And so we will continue to ask people to move their  
8 vehicles when they are parked illegally.

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: And are they parked  
10 illegally in front of certain residents' homes or

11 MR. BHABHRAWALA: They're parked illegally in  
12 front of a crosswalk, which is at the intersection of  
13 the store, as well as sometimes in the alley, which  
14 blocks the parking ways to people's homes.

15 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. I don't want to  
16 belabor this too long, but how do you ask them? Do you  
17 go into the store and look for them?

18 MR. BHABHRAWALA: I do and I ask them to move  
19 their vehicle and tell them that they are parked  
20 illegally. I've done this on a number of occasions. A  
21 couple of other people have done that as well.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So

1 MR. DIETZ: It's not our concern.

2 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: That's not your concern.

3 Okay.

4 MR. DIETZ: No, our concern is entering the  
5 store.

6 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: So for what -- not to --  
7 for this purpose of for any purpose just

8 MR. DIETZ: Pardon?

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: For this purpose? Not  
10 entering the store to do what?

11 MR. DIETZ: They enter the store to disrupt  
12 the business, you know, just disruptive activity,  
13 taking photographs, other things. Okay. Yeah.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: To take photographs for  
15 their case? Okay.

16 MR. BHABHRAWALA: Madam Chair, I don't know  
17 about the other protestants. I know we have about 16  
18 people that have standing in this. I can certainly  
19 speak for myself on this. I have never gone into the  
20 store to take photographs. I have gone in to ask the  
21 applicants to move vehicles or tell their customers to  
22 move their vehicles. I do apologize if this is

1 harassing to the business but it's also harassing to  
2 the community.

3           And we think that there is priority there  
4 when cars are parked illegally.

5           CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. I just have a  
6 couple of things to say; one is I'm looking at my sheet  
7 and, if I'm reading it correctly, you have a mediation  
8 coming up on July 23rd.

9           MR. DIETZ: No, we don't.

10           CHAIRPERSON MILLER: You don't? Okay. I'll  
11 take that out. So there won't be any more mediation.  
12 You just -- okay. I mean, I would just suggest, if  
13 you're talking about cars being parked illegally, that  
14 you could telephone -- may I have your telephone so he  
15 doesn't have to come into the store?

16           MR. DIETZ: Please, the parking is the --  
17 parking enforcement is the activity of DOT and not the  
18 liquor store. The liquor store has clearly posted no  
19 parking signs and no loitering signs.

20           CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

21           MR. DIETZ: The -- other than buying a tow  
22 truck and moving the vehicles themselves, there's

1 nothing my client can do about it. If the vehicle's  
2 blocking a public alley, then it's up to DOT to do the  
3 enforcement.

4 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

5 MR. DIETZ: I also suggest that if there's  
6 criminal activities being observed, that a police  
7 officer be called and not taking into their own hands  
8 to -- to try to enforce the law. That's property of  
9 Metropolitan Police Department, not an individual.

10 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. If you have a  
11 problem with that, you can call the police to enforce  
12 parking.

13 MR. BHABHRAWALA: Okay.

14 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. All right. Yes,  
15 I certainly wouldn't endorse harassment and it doesn't  
16 sound like you intend to do any more photographing.  
17 But you've done what you need to do?

18 MR. BHABHRAWALA: We have plenty of evidence  
19 on it, Madam Chair.

20 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay.

21 MR. BHABHRAWALA: Thank you.

22 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Okay. So hopefully,

1 that's not an issue anymore. Okay. So I want to read  
2 you just basic instructions to make sure that you  
3 understand what you're going forward with the protest.  
4 You should have received a mailing from adjudication  
5 assistant, Sarah Fashbaugh, a letter explaining the  
6 protest process and a copy of a protest information  
7 form.

8           If you don't have these documents, please see  
9 her at the conclusion of the hearing. You need to get  
10 those documents. It's important that you review the  
11 rules closely and adhere to them before and during the  
12 protest hearing. You're required to complete and  
13 submit the protest information form -- it's a PIF --  
14 seven days before the date of the hearing.

15           This document needs to be submitted to ABRA  
16 and to the opposing parties in this matter. If we do  
17 not receive of copy of your PIF, your application or  
18 your protest, whichever side you're representing will  
19 be subject to dismissal. And pay attention to the  
20 deadline because cases have been dismissed if they  
21 haven't been submitted in a timely manner. So pay  
22 attention to that seven days. And on that, you'll also

2 Okay. So if you have any other questions,  
3 you should call Ms. Fashbaugh at 202-397-3971.

4 MR. DIETZ: I have one quick --

5 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: Quick question for us?  
6 Okay.

7 MR. DIETZ: How much time will be allotted to  
8 each side to present their case?

9 CHAIRPERSON MILLER: An hour and a half.

10 MR. DIETZ: Thank you.

12 cross on a witness but not your witness being crossed.

13 MR. DIETZ: Thank you.

18 more than enough time. Okay. Anything else?
