**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT OF APPLICATION**

The Application filed by Jackie Lee, Inc., t/a Jackie Lee Lounge, for renewal of its Retailer's Class CN License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on April 18, 2011, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On April 18, 2011, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (23 DCMR) § 1602.3 (2004), the Board dismissed the Application due to the Applicant's failure to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. The Applicant is James E. Adkins, who died on September 10, 2010. On January 6, 2011, the Circuit Court for Pinellas County, Florida, issued Letters of Administration appointing Stacy Adkins as the single, Personal Representative of the estate of James E. Adkins.

On April 27, 2011, the Applicant filed a Motion for Reinstatement of Application for Renewal of Retailer's Class CN License and Motion for Reconsideration of Order on Dismissal of Application to Renew License indicating that Stacy Adkins was unable to be present at the hearing due to his responsibilities as Personal Representative in connection

with a case in the Superior Court Division, Alamance County, North Carolina. Therefore, Gerald Adkins, Stacy Adkins's brother, attended the hearing as the designated representative of the James E. Adkins estate, and because Stacy Adkins was *pro se* at the time of the hearing, he was unaware that he was required to authorize, in writing, Gerald Adkins to appear as the designated representative for the estate of James E. Adkins. Upon consideration of this request to reinstate the Applicant, the Board finds good cause to reinstate the Applicant.


### **ORDER**






