ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

In Board Order No. 2016-306, the Board canceled the Retailer's Class CR License held by The Johnny Rockets Group, Inc., t/a Johnny Rockets, based on the failure to pay its renewal fees in a timely fashion despite being on notice that such a payment was due. *In re The Johnny Rockets Group, Inc., t/a Johnny Rockets*, ABRA License No. 081606, Board Order No. 2016-306, 1 (D.C.A.B.C.B. May 18, 2016).


The license holder filed a motion for reconsideration, dated May 26, 2016, which provides no reason for the failure to pay its renewal fees. Consequently, the Board has been provided with no reason to reverse its decision to cancel the license.

The Board notes that it recently allowed the moratorium on the issuance of new Retailer's Class CR Licenses to expire; therefore, Johnny Rockets is free to apply for a new Retailer's Class CR License when it is ready to reopen.

ORDER

Therefore, on this 8th day of June 2016, the Board hereby **DENIES** the motion for reconsideration. A copy of this Order shall be delivered to the license holder.





Pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
