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**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND  
REINSTATING LICENSE**

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On May 5, 2021, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) cancelled the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-099451 held by Flores, LLC, t/a Joselyn Restaurant Bar & Lounge (Petitioner), because the Petitioner requested the cancellation of its license. *See* Board Order No. 2021-258.

On June 29, 2021, Favian Argueta Flores, on behalf of the Petitioner, sought reinstatement of the Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-099451. In support of his request for reinstatement, Mr. Argueta Flores stated that he has a Stock Transfer Application pending before the Board and the license needs to be reinstated for the Board to approve his pending Application.

The Board finds that the reinstatement of the license is proper.

Accordingly, it is this 15th day of July 2021, **ORDERED** that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against the Petitioner, by the Board on May 5, 2020, be and hereby is **VACATED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that its Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-099451 be **REINSTATED**.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879- 1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
