3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case on
4 our calendar is Case No. 19-CMP-00104, Kitty
5 O'Shea's DC, License No. 90464. Will the parties
6 please approach and identify themselves for the
7 record, please?

8 MR. CURTIS: My name is Dylan Curtis,
9 General Manager of Kitty O'Shea's, representing
10 Thirteenth Step, LLC.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Your last name,
12 sir?

13 MR. CURTIS: Curtis.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Curtis, do
15 you have a letter of authorization with you, sir?

16 MR. CURTIS: I do.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Can we have
18 that, please? Are there any preliminary matters
19 in this case?

20 MR. ORTIZ: Yes. As to Charge 1, no
21 ABC manager, the parties have entered into an
22 offer in compromise, which is the establishment
23 shall pay \$2,000.00 within 30 days or its license
24 shall be suspended indefinitely until this fine
25 is paid.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Curtis, it's
2 my understanding there is an offer in compromise,
3 and the offer in compromise is that there is a
4 fine of \$2,000.00 payable within 30 days. If the
5 fine is not paid within 30 days, the license will
6 be suspended until the fine has been paid. Is
7 this your understanding of the offer in
8 compromise?

9 MR. CURTIS: Yes, it is.

10 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware
11 that by accepting an offer in compromise that
12 you're giving up your right to a hearing?

13 MR. CURTIS: Yes.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also
15 aware that by accepting an offer in compromise
16 that you give up your right to appeal this
17 matter?

18 MR. CURTIS: Yes.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All this being
20 said, I made a motion that the offer in
21 compromise of a fine of \$2,000.00 payable within
22 30 days be accepted. If the fine is not paid
23 within 30 days, the license will be suspended
24 until the fine has been paid. Is there a second?

25 MS. CROCKETT: Second.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Ms. Crockett has
2 second the motion. All those in favor say aye.

3 (CHORUS OF AYES.)

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?
5 The matter passed 6-0-0. With that said, the
6 Board will be in recess until our 11:30 hearing.
7 Thank you.
