**ORDER GRANTING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE**

On April 29, 2015, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2015-236 cancelling Ventura Market, LLC, t/a LaJoya Steakhouse Restaurant (Licensee) License No. ABRA-093124. Specifically, the Licensee failed to make the second year payment for its license by March 31, 2014, and the third year payment by March 31, 2015. *See* Board Order No. 2015-236.

On May 26, 2015, the Licensee paid the license fees for the periods of 2014 to 2015 and 2015 to 2016 and the associated late fees.

It is hereby **ORDERED**, that the **ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE** issued against Ventura Market, LLC, t/a LaJoya Steakhouse Restaurant, located at 201 Upshur Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., by the Board on April 29, 2015, be and hereby is **VACATED** and **REINSTATE** its Retailer Class CR License ABRA-093124. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Licensee.



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Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
