3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The next case on  
4 our calendar is Case Number 18-AUD-00107,  
5 Laliguras Indian & Nepali Bistro, License Number  
6 95042.

7 Would the parties please approach and  
8 identify themselves for the record, please.

9 MR. RIVERO: Good morning, Board  
10 Members. Fernando Rivero for the District of  
11 Columbia.

12 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Rivero.

13 MR. TAMANG: Good morning, Board  
14 Member. I am Dawa Tamang from Laliguras Indian &  
15 Nepali Bistro.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry, sir,  
17 I did not hear your last name.

18 MR. TAMANG: Dawa Tamang.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Tamang?

20 MR. TAMANG: Yes.

21 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning,  
22 Mr. Tamang.

1 All right. Are there any preliminary  
2 matters in this case?

3 MR. RIVERO: Yes. The parties have an  
4 offer in compromise to present to the Board at  
5 this time. And the offer consists of a fine of  
6 \$2,000 within 30 days. If the fine is not paid  
7 within 30 days, the license will be suspended  
8 until the payment is received, that is, the fine.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you.

10 Mr. Tamang, it's my understanding that  
11 there is an offer in compromise. And the offer  
12 in compromise is a fine of \$2,000 payable within  
13 30 days. If the fine is not payable within 30  
14 days, the license will be suspended until the  
15 fine has been paid.

16 Is this your understanding, sir, of  
17 the offer in compromise?

18 MR. TAMANG: Yes, sir. I understand.

19 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you aware  
20 that by accepting an offer in compromise that  
21 you're giving up your rights to appeal this  
22 matter?

1 MR. TAMANG: Yes, sir.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Are you also  
3 aware that by accepting an offer in compromise  
4 you're giving up your rights -- I'm sorry.

5 Are you aware that by accepting an  
6 offer in compromise that you are giving up your  
7 right to contest this matter? That's the first  
8 question I should have asked you.

9 And then the second question, are you  
10 aware that by accepting an offer in compromise  
11 you're giving up your right to appeal this  
12 matter?

13 MR. TAMANG: Okay, sir. Yes, sir.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes.

15 With that said, I make a motion that  
16 the offer in compromise of a fine of \$2,000  
17 payable in 30 days be accepted. If the fine is  
18 not payable in 30 days, the license will be  
19 suspended until the fine has been paid.

20 Is there a second?

21 MEMBER CATO: Second.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Cato seconds

1 the motion.

2 All those in favor, say aye.

3 (Chorus of ayes.)

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Those opposed?

5 (No response.)

6 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The matter  
7 passes 5-0-0. Thank you.

8 Mr. Tamang, this is your sixth  
9 secondary tier violation for failing to file a  
10 quarterly statement. Are you aware, sir, that  
11 the agency provides training?

12 MR. TAMANG: Right. Right. Because,  
13 you know, I didn't understand this at all work.  
14 And I give the responsibility for my accountant.  
15 Accountant make mistake every time.

16 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Well, maybe he  
17 --

18 MR. TAMANG: If I wait today to tell  
19 this all matter, then he will have to do the not  
20 any mistake, all of my monthly or quarterly  
21 statements to submit it.

22 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: The agency

1 offers training, sir. Although we can't say our  
2 accountants made the mistake because you're the  
3 one who's responsible.

4 MS. GILBERT: So --

5 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No, I'm just  
6 saying we are here to help you, sir. So the  
7 agency offers, we provide training. You can  
8 reach out to us at any point. We will work with  
9 you to make sure that you do it right, unless you  
10 want to give us, keep on giving us \$2,000.

11 So, that's your call.

12 MR. TAMANG: So, the Board will provide  
13 training to me how to do it, how to have done  
14 this all?

15 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Yes, sir.

16 So, could someone give him a card. I  
17 think is that Ms. -- We'll make sure, we'll put  
18 you in contact with the person who can sit down  
19 with you and go through the process of what is it  
20 that you need to do.

21 Sir, our job is to help you, is to  
22 facilitate this.

1 MR. TAMANG: Yes, I understand.

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Our job. We're  
3 not trying to take your money, not this way  
4 anyway.

5 MR. TAMANG: This is absolutely right,  
6 Board Member, because I'm, because, you know, I'm  
7 losing everywhere. Things applying and losing  
8 the other place, and because this is a big  
9 problem with me. I would like to learn  
10 everything rather than the payment.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. So,  
12 could just someone put in, invite Ms. Clark here  
13 to sit with him, and they can make some  
14 arrangement?

15 I'm moving forward. Okay, sir?

16 MR. TAMANG: Thank you. I appreciate,  
17 Board Member.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Have a good day.  
19 All right.
