
ORDER GRANTING GOVERNMENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

This matter comes before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) as a Show Cause Hearing in Case Nos. 16-CMP-00155 and 16-CMP-00189 against Langston Bar and Grille, LLC, t/a Langston Bar & Grille (Respondent).

At the Show Cause Hearing, the District of Columbia (Government) moved the Board to dismiss the cases because the Respondent paid the citations that formed the basis of the charges listed in the Show Cause Notice. Specially, the Respondent paid \$500.00 on March 30, 2016, to satisfy the amount owed for Citation No. 4525 and \$500.00 on August 10, 2016, to satisfy the amount owed for Citation No. 4522.

For these reasons, on this 10th day of August, 2016, the Board hereby **GRANTS** the Government's Motion and **DISMISSES** Case Nos. 16-CMP-00155 and 16-CMP-00189 against the Respondent. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Respondent and the Government.





Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
