ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST

The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) has determined that the Application for renewal filed by YD Progress, LLC, t/a Lucky Corner Store, located at 5433 Georgia Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C., a Retailer's Class B License, was protested by ANC 4D.

On December 8, 2014, a Protest Status Hearing was held and the Board dismissed the Application because the Licensee failed to appear at the Protest Status Hearing. *See* Board Order No. 2014-513.

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that YD Progress, LLC, t/a Lucky Corner Store, did not file a Request for Reinstatement with the Board within ten (10) days from the date of Order No. 2014-513, dated December 10, 2014. Additionally, Lucky Corner Store did not submit a new Renewal Application.

Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 you are therefore **ORDERED** by the Board on this 21st day of January, 2015, to **STOP selling alcoholic beverages at 5433 Georgia Avenue,**

N.W. Washington, D.C. You may not allow the sale of alcoholic beverages on the premises until your ABC License is reinstated by the Board.





Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
