**ORDER ON WITHDRAWAL OF PROTEST OF ANC 6C**

The Application filed by Meatballs E St, LLC, t/a Meatballs, for a new Retailer's Class DR License, located at 624 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., having been protested by ANC 6C, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on December 27, 2011, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On December 19, 2011, Chairperson Karen Wirt, on behalf of ANC 6C, submitted a letter indicating that the Applicant has met the neighborhood's requirements, including: changing the application to reflect a change of class from a Retailer's Class CR License to a Retailer's Class DR License and changing the hours of operation to be at parity with the establishment nearby.

**ORDER**







Dear Mr. Moosally:

Commissioner Kevin Wilsey, the designated representative for ANC 6C (see my letter of December 19, 2011), informs me that Meatballs has met two of the neighborhood requirements that resulted from the ANC 6C protest of the license based on disturbance of the peace, order, and quiet of the neighborhood. The requirements are:

- (1) Change the application to a DR license, restaurant establishment, that serves only beer and wine, and
- (2) Change the hours of operation to be at parity with Luke's Lobster establishment nearby.

Based on a good-faith exchange between the establishment representatives and Commissioner Wilsey, assurances from the applicant that these conditions will remain intact, and my communication with the Commissioner, ANC 6C hereby withdraws its protest of this liquor license, based on its December 15, 2011, vote and the understanding that conditions 1 and 2 above shall remain part of the ABRA record.

Dear Mr. Moosally:

On December 15, 2011, at a duly noticed, regularly scheduled, monthly meeting of ANC 6C, with a quorum of 6 out of 9 commissioners and the public present, the above-mentioned item came before us.

Commissioner Kevin Wilsey stated that the ANC is in the process of negotiating a voluntary agreement with the applicant and has filed a protest based on disturbance to the peace, order, and quiet. He stated that the applicant is seeking a class C license, which would allow serving beer, wine, and spirits. The community wants the establishment to have a class D license, which would limit the serving of alcoholic beverages to beer and wine. Commissioner is the designated representative on matters pertaining to this establishment.

The commissioners voted unanimously, 6:0:0, to support the neighborhood request that the applicant be issued a class D license. The vote included the request that the applicant does not need to replacard when making this change to a D license request.
