ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE


The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Joan F. Lewis, t/a Mixers Lounge located at 104 Kennedy Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., has failed to renew License No. ABRA-017578, a Retailer's Class CT License. Specifically, you failed to renew your license by September 30, 2010, the deadline for all Retailer's Class CT licenses, despite being notified of the renewal date.


