ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Capital Yacht Charters, LLC, t/a Motor Yacht Celebrity (1 of 3), (Respondent), located at 1300 Maine Avenue, S.W., Washington, D.C., has failed to pay the third year license fees for its License No. ABRA-084410, a Retailer's Class CX Marine Vessel License. Specifically, the Respondent failed to make the third year payment for its license by March 31, 2015, the deadline for all Retailer's Class CX Marine Vessel licenses, despite being notified by ABRA of the payment date.

On April 22, 2015, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against the Respondent, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to make the third year payment for its Retailer's Class CX Marine Vessel License. On April 23, 2015, ABRA's Enforcement Division confirmed that the Respondent is out of business.

It is hereby **ORDERED** on this 29th day of April, 2015, that Capital Yacht Charters, LLC's License No. ABRA-084410 is **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be sent to the Respondent.

Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals on the motion.
