**ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE**

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) was informed that Kiel, LLC, t/a Mova (Licensee), located at 2204 14th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., has ceased operations.

On August 11, 2015, the ABRA's Licensing Division mailed via United States Postal Service (USPS) a written notice to the Licensee. The notice advised the Petitioner that if it was no longer operational, the license must be surrendered to the Board for safekeeping or the license would be cancelled pursuant to the District of Columbia Official Code § 25-791. ABRA mailed the notice to the Petitioner at his address of record, but the notice was returned undeliverable to ABRA.

On August 25, 2015, the ABRA's Enforcement Division confirmed that the Licensee is out of business.



Under 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
