ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE


The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Bak's Family Enterprises, Inc., t/a New Star Supermarket, (Respondent), located at 2205 4th Street, N.E., Washington, D.C., has failed to pay the third year license fees for its License No. ABRA-077147 a Retailer's Class B License. Specifically, the Respondent failed to make the third year payment for its license by September 30, 2013, the deadline for all Retailer's B licenses, despite being notified of the payment date.


On October 23, 2013, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against Bak's Family Enterprises, Inc., t/a New Star Supermarket, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to renew its Retailer's Class B License. ABRA's Enforcement Division confirmed that the Respondent is out of business.




