8 The second violation here is requesting a 9 report for second quarter, 2014. Actually the 10 restaurant was closed. We didn't even have the 11 license at the time. The license was issued on 12 July 31st.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: You said two --14 well, from what I have in front of me it says, 15 failure to file quarterly statements for the 16 second quarter for 2015. That's the only --17 that's the case --
