1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right. The next
3 case on our show cause hearing calendar -- calendar is
4 Case Number 15-CMP-00763, Ping Pong, License Number
5 86270. Mr. Rivero.

6 MR. RIVERO: Good -- good morning, Board
7 Members. Fernando Rivero for the District of Columbia
8 standing in for Amy Schmidt. The Government will be
9 moving to dismiss this case at this time. The
10 establishment is no longer in operation and failed to
11 renew its license. I understand it's in the cease and
12 desist list.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay. The Government
14 has moved to dismiss. I -- I make a motion that we
15 accept the Government motion.

16 MR. SHORT: Second.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short has
18 seconded the motion. Those in favor say aye. [Chorus
19 of ayes]. Those opposed. [No audible response]. The
20 matter passed 4-zero-zero. So the matter is dismissed.
