11 me for the last four years that I've been chair.

14 service to the residents of the District of
15 Columbia.

17 record, you are free to say so. If you want to,
18 but you don't have to.

19 MS. PHILLIPS: Well, it was a pleasure
20 serving in front of the Alcohol Board. You
21 always showed great respect for our attorneys
22 which is not always the case in the judicial

1 context, shall I say. I was pleased to serve.
2 Only 28 years and four months. Hardly any time
3 at all.

4 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you very
5 much.

6 Go ahead, Mr. Silverstein.

7 MEMBER SILVERSTEIN: Mr. Chairman, I
8 would like to echo your kind remarks regarding
9 Ms. Phillips' service. It's been longer than
10 that that we have worked together from different
11 sides of this podium.

12 I have appreciated your diligence,
13 your hard work, your efficiency and, above all,
14 your kindness. Thank you. I wish you well. I
15 thank you for your service to the District and I
16 thank you for your kindness to all of us.
17 Thanks. God's speed.

18 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Mr. Short.
19 You can't leave. We're not done.
20 (Laughter.)

21 MEMBER SHORT: I, too, would like to
22 reflect, as our Chairman and board member have

1 stated, it's been a pleasure working with you and
2 we wish you well in whatever endeavors you move
3 on into from here. It's been a pleasure and
4 thank you. Best wishes.

5 MS. PHILLIPS: Thank you, sir. I
6 appreciate your recognizing some of the fire and
7 safety issues from your background that we
8 recognize in some of our hearings as being
9 important while maybe slightly outside the ABRA
10 context. I appreciate that, too.

11 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Thank you, Ms.
12 Phillips.

13 MS. PHILLIPS: Thank you.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: We're off the
15 record.
