ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE


The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Port of Piraeus II, Inc., t/a Port Of Piraeus II, located at 1155 21st Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., has failed to renew its License No. ABRA-015118, a Retailer's Class B License. Specifically, you failed to renew your license by September 30, 2011, the deadline for all Retailer's Class B licenses, despite being notified of the renewal date.

On December 14, 2011, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against Port of Piraeus II, Inc., t/a Port Of Piraeus II, located at 1155 21st Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to renew its Retailer's Class B License.


