**ORDER DENYING LICENSEE'S REQUEST FOR  
REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE**

On June 1, 2011, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist No. 2011-258 against Regal Cuisine, LLC, t/a Regal Cuisine, located at 216 P Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to pay the second year license fee for the period of 2011 to 2012 of its License No. ABRA-075702, a Retailer's Class Caterer License. *See* Board Order No. 2011-258. Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) mailed the Order to the Licensee at his address of record, and no returned mail was received by ABRA.

On July 27, 2011, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2011-326 cancelling the Licensee's License No. ABRA-075702. *See* Board Order No. 2011-326. ABRA mailed the Order to the Licensee at his address of record, and again, and no returned mail was received by ABRA.

On March 12, 2013, the Licensee sought reinstatement of its Caterer License No. ABRA-075702, submitting that License No. ABRA-075702 issued on April 1, 2010, is valid through March 31, 2013, and thus should never have been cancelled. Additionally, the Licensee informed ABRA staff on March 12, 2013 that he has been the in-house vendor at the National Museum of Women in the Arts since 2000, and that he did not receive an Order cancelling his license. The National Museum of Women in the Arts is located at 1250 New York Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C.

ABC licenses are issued for a three year period and licensees are permitted to pay the three years fee in full, or in annual installments over that three year period.

ABRA's records indicate that on April 1, 2010, the Licensee renewed its license and paid the first year license fee for the period of 2010 to 2011. There is no record of the Licensee's payment for the second year of its license. In addition, according to ABRA's records, the Licensee's business address is 216 P Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. There has been no request for a change of address by the Licensee.


Based upon the above, the Board finds that Licensee did not pay the second year license fee for its License No. ABRA-075702 and the Licensee's explanation for failure to pay does not constitute good cause under 23 DCMR § 1602.3. Therefore, the Licensee's request for reinstatement is denied.

### **ORDER**

The Board does hereby, this 20th day of March, 2013, **DENY** the reinstatement of the Licensee's License No. ABRA-075702. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Licensee.


