2 ROLL CALL HEARING

3 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Would the parties
4 in the matter of Some Place Else Bar & Grill
5 please come forward? Some Place Else Bar &
6 Grill? This is case #16-PRO-00059, 1637 R
7 Street, LLC, trading as Some Place Else Bar &
8 Grill, 1637 R Street Northwest, license #ABRA-
9 00059. This is a Retailer class CR license
10 renewal. The protest issues are adverse impact
11 on peace, order and quiet. Introductions
12 beginning with the applicant please. Your name,
13 sir?

14 MR. HALL: John Hall.

15 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: John, what's the last
16 name?

17 MR. HALL: Hall, H-A-L-L.

18 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Thank you very much.
19 And present on behalf of ANC 2B?

20 MR. UPRIGHT: Commissioner Michael Upright.

21 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: How do you spell the
22 last name, commissioner?

1 MR. UPRIGHT: U-P-R-I-G-H-T, just like it
2 sounds.

3 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: The cleaner.

4 MR. UPRIGHT: Exactly.

5 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Thank you. ANC 2B
6 does have standing as a protestant. We need to
7 set a date for a status hearing, a protest
8 hearing and a mediation. I'll give you the dates
9 for the status and the protest hearing first.
10 The date of the status hearing is set for
11 September 14 at 9:30.

12 MR. HALL: Is there any possibility of doing
13 it any later than that?

14 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: I'm sorry, what was
15 that, Mr. Hall?

16 MR. HALL: Can we do the hearing in the
17 afternoon?

18 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: They're only at 9:30
19 a.m., the status hearings. September 14 at 9:30.
20 The protest hearing is set for October 26 at
21 1:30, October 26 at 1:30. We need to set a date
22 for a mediation. The next available date for

1 mediation is Thursday, August 11, at 9:00, 10:00
2 or 11:00 or 1:00.

3 MR. HALL: 9:00 if we can, please.

4 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Would 9:00 be okay for
5 you, Mr. Hall?

6 MR. HALL: 9:00 Thursday the --

7 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: August the 11th.

8 MR. HALL: That's fine.

9 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Mr. Hall, did you put
10 your contact information on that sheet? I'm
11 sorry, not Mr. Hall, Mr. Upright.

12 MR. UPRIGHT: Yes, I did.

13 CHAIRPERSON FLETCHER: Okay, thank you very
