ORDER VACATING CEASE AND DESIST

On May 1, 2014, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2014-165 ordering Saigon Bistro, LLC, t/a Saigon Bistro (Respondent), holder of a Retailer's Class CR License No. ABRA-081175, to stop selling, serving, or permitting the consumption of alcoholic beverages at its establishment until payment of the second year license fees and any associated fines are received by ABRA.

On May 2, 2014, the Respondent paid the license fees for the period of 2014 to 2015 and the associated late fees.

It is hereby **ORDERED**, that the **ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST** issued against Saigon Bistro, LLC, t/a Saigon Bistro, located at 2153-2155 P Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., by the Board on May 1, 2014, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), be and hereby is **VACATED**.

Effective May 2, 2014.




