ORDER VACATING CEASE AND DESIST

On October 23, 2013, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2013-476 ordering RA-IY, LLC, t/a Sankofa Café (Respondent), holder of a Retailer's Class CT License No. ABRA-086424, to stop selling, serving, or permitting the consumption of alcoholic beverages at its establishment until the Respondent pays the required renewal fee and any associated fines owed to the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration.

On November 8, 2013, the Respondent paid the renewal fee and the associated late fees.



Effective November 8, 2013.






