
ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE


The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that De Amigo, LLC, t/a Sesto Senso/ Andalu/Spot/Lupe/MIA, (Respondent), has failed to pay the second year license fees for its License No. ABRA-081092, a Retailer's Class CT License. Specifically, the Respondent failed to make the second year payment for its license by September 30, 2014, the deadline for all Retailer's CT licenses, despite being notified by ABRA of the payment date.

On October 15, 2014, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against De Amigo, LLC, t/a Sesto Senso/ Andalu/Spot/Lupe/MIA, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to pay the second year license fees for its Retailer's Class CT License.


