ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE IN SAFEKEEPING


The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Thalia, LLC, t/a Slaviya, is in safekeeping and has failed to pay the second year license fees for License No. ABRA-083910, a Retailer's Class CR license. Specifically, the Respondent failed to make the second year payment for its license by March 31, 2014, the deadline for all Retailer's CR licenses, despite being notified of the payment date.

Under 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, under section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration under 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
