PROTEST HEARING (STATUS)

Our next on our protest hearing calendar is case #16-PRO-00059, Someplace Else Bar and Grill, license ##98935. Will the parties please approach and identify themselves for the record, please?

MR. RIZVI: Khawar Rizvi. Manager of Some Place Else, on behalf of --

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I did not hear your first or last name.

MR. RIZVI: K-H-A-W-A-R, R-I-Z-V-I.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I-Z --

MR. RIZVI: R-I-Z-V-I.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: And who are you, sir?

MR. RIZVI: I am manager at Some Place Else, standing for Jennifer Smith. She is not -- she is hospitalized, she is not mobile and cannot appear before you.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Did she provide you with authorization to represent her.

MR. RIZVI: It is in the record from the beginning.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I'm sorry, sir?

MR. RIZVI: It is in the record from the beginning, from the time the license was issued, I'm working there as a manager.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: No, that's not the question I asked, sir. Did she provide the board today with authorization to say that you can represent her today in front of this status hearing?

MR. RIZVI: I thought it -- she told me to go and I thought that if I --

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I don't know who you are, sir, I've never -- this is -- I'm new, so whatever, if you've been here before, so -- anyone can -- anyone can show up at a status hearing to state that "I'm here representing ownership," and so the owner is supposed to provide us with something written. So, what I'm going to do is that -- why don't you step back a minute? I'm going to recall this case, okay? and

the board will get some clarification and I'll let you know.

MR. RIZVI: Okay.

CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, I'll recall this case.
