ORDER GRANTING CONTINUANCE OF THE PROTEST PROCEEDINGS

This case arises from the Application filed by Adams Morgan Spaghetti Garden, Inc. t/a Spaghetti Garden Brass Monkey for renewal of its Retailer's Class CR License. The Application was timely protested by Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 1C, and the parties came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on June 13, 2016, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2015).

The ANC now comes before the Board seeking a continuance of the Protest Status Hearing currently scheduled for September 21, 2016, and the Protest Hearing currently scheduled for October 26, 2016. The Applicant consents to the requested continuance and the parties indicate the delay is needed to further settlement discussions and resolution of the issues.

In light of the foregoing, the Board finds good cause to grant the requested continuance.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED on the 7th of September 2016 that the Agreed Motion is **GRANTED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Protest Status Hearing is now scheduled for February 8, 2017 at 9:30 AM and the Protest Hearing is scheduled for March 15, 2017 at 1:30 P.M.





Pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. *See* D.C. App. Rule 15(b).
