ORDER DENYING REINSTATEMENT

The Application filed by The Stadium Group, LLC, Inc., t/a Stadium (Applicant) for renewal of its Retailer's Class CN License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) for a Status Hearing on July 14, 2010, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On July 14, 2010, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations ("23 DCMR") § 1603.3 (2004), the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) dismissed the Henderson Group of Five for failure to appear timely at the Status Hearing. The Henderson Group of Five timely filed a request for reinstatement with the Board, indicating that they did not receive notice. Upon consideration of the request, the Board does not find good cause to reinstate the Henderson Group of Five pursuant to 23 D.C.M.R. 1603.3. The Padou Group of Five remains a Protestant in this matter.






