ORDER ON WITHDRAWAL OF PROTEST

The Application for a new Retailer's Class CR License, filed by Food Service, LLC, t/a Standard ("Applicant"), at 1801 14th Street, N.W., Washington D.C., having been protested by ANC 1B, represented by Commissioner Peter J. Raia, and ANC 2B, represented by Commissioner Ramon Estrada, initially came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on April 5, 2010, and a Status Hearing on May 5, 2010, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001). ANC 1B was dismissed as a Protest because it failed to appear at the Roll Call Hearing. ANC 1B later requested reinstatement but was denied by the Board. The protest did not proceed to a Protest Hearing because ANC 2B entered into a Voluntary Agreement, dated June 14, 2010, with the Applicant.

The Voluntary Agreement was approved by Board Order No. 2010-373. On November 10, 2010, the Board vacated Order No. 2010-373, dated June 23, 2010, which approved the VA and reinstated the protest of ANC 2B. The Status Hearing was held on November 17, 2010.

On November 30, 2010, Chairperson Will Stephens, on behalf of ANC 2B, withdrew the Protest filed by ANC 2B.

Accordingly, it is this 1st day of December 2010, **ORDERED** that:


