AND F&M ENTERPRISES, LLC**


The Application filed by GBP, LLC, t/a Tackle Box, for renewal of its Retailer's Class CT License, located at 3245 M Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., was protested by abutting property owners 2441 Bond St. Equities, LLC, and F&M Enterprises, LLC. The Roll Call Hearing was held on June 3, 2013 and a Protest Status Hearing on July 31, 2013, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601.

On July 22 and July 23, 2014, Kwamina Williford, Esq., on behalf of 2441 Bond St. Equities, LLC, and Richard G. Price, on behalf of F&M Enterprises, LLC, submitted correspondence indicating that they were withdrawing their protests.


ORDER

Pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (April 2004), any Party adversely affected by this Order may file a Motion for Reconsideration within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433, stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b).
