**ORDER DENYING FRANCIS L. YOUNG'S REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT**

The Application filed by The Old Naval Hospital Foundation, t/a The Old Naval Hospital Foundation (Applicant), for a new Retailer's Class CX Multipurpose License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on July 18, 2011, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

On July 18 2011, pursuant to Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations ("23 DCMR") § 1602.3 (2004), the Board dismissed 121 Individuals as protestants with the Group of Five or More Individuals for failure to appear at the Roll Call Hearing, and they did not designate a representative.

On August 2, 2011, Francis L. Young, one of the 121 Individuals dismissed, filed a request for reinstatement indicating that the Roll Call Hearing was scheduled in the middle of summer vacations, and her concerns about the Application may not be addressed by the Group of Five or More Individuals (approximately 27 Individuals). Upon consideration of






