ORDER AMENDING BOARD ORDER NO. 2016-125


The Settlement Agreement filed by Madras Bar, LLC, t/a The Airedale (Licensee), initially came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for its approval on March 16, 2016. On March 16, 2016, the Board issued Order No. 2016-125, approving the Settlement Agreement, dated March 9, 2016.

The Settlement Agreement contained typographical errors regarding the establishment's hours of operation and sales. It is intended by the Parties that the Settlement Agreement setting forth the Licensee's hours of operation for the Summer Garden and Sidewalk Café on Sunday should read "7:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m."; the hours for selling and serving alcohol for the Summer Garden on Sunday should read "8:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m."; and the hours for selling and serving alcohol for the Sidewalk Café on Sunday should read "8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m."

Therefore, it is hereby, **ORDERED** on this 11th day of May, 2016, that:

1. The establishment's hours of operation for the Summer Garden and Sidewalk Café on Sunday should read "7:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.";
2. The establishment's hours for selling and serving alcohol for the Summer Garden on Sunday should read "8:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m."; and
3. The establishment's hours for selling and serving alcohol for the Sidewalk Café on Sunday should read "8:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m."
4. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Licensee and ANC 1A.





Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
