Also, pursuant to section II of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thi1ty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Coult of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).

Conditioned upon conclusion of public hearings before the Community, and ANC 5C, the parties agree to have the ABRA Board issue a consent order imposing conditions on the license authorizing the issuance of a Retailer's Class "C" Tavern License to the Applicant and imposing conditions on the license.

Agreement

Board APPROVE the Application for a New Retailer's Class CT License at premises 1601 Rhode Island Avenue, N.E. filed by ICHPROP, LLC, t/a The Public Option subject to the following **CONDITIONS** agreed to by the parties:

- 1. The license holder's hours of operation and hours of sale, service, and the consumption of alcoholic beverages for the interior shall not begin before 8:00 a.m. or exceed 2:00 a.m. on any day of the week.
- 2. The license holder's hours of operation and hours of sale, service, and consumption of alcoholic beverages for the sidewalk cafe shall not begin before 8:00 a.m. on any day of the week or exceed 1:00 a.m. on any day of the week. Additionally, all live entertainment on the sidewalk cafe may not exceed 10:00 p.m. on any day of the week.
- 3. The conditions contained in this agreement shall not prevent or prohibit the license holder from applying for, receiving, or operating under any extended hours or additional hours granted under the law.
- 4. The license holder shall not operate the establishment as a nightclub.
- 5. The license holder shall may have cover charges, related to live entertainment.
- 6. The license holder shall have a dance floor limited to the interior only.
- 7. The license holder shall not have VIP table service.
- 8. The license holder shall not have VIP bottle service.
- 9. The license holder shall exercise limits on amplified music or sound to end at 1am on the interior, and end at 10pm on the sidewalk café.

The Applicant agrees that the failure to adhere to these conditions imposed by this agreement may be enforced under D.C. Official Code § 25-823(a)(6) (requiring compliance with ABRA Board orders) and 25-823(a)(7)(requiring compliance with "the terms of ... [the] license approved by the Board.").
