ORDER VACATING CEASE AND DESIST

On November 4 and November 18, 2015, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order Nos. 2015-505 and 2015-545, ordering Mahogany, LLC, t/a The Tap & Parlour/Bohemian Caverns (Respondent), holder of a Retailer's Class CT License No. ABRA-074895, to stop selling, serving, or permitting the consumption of alcoholic beverages at its establishment until payment of the second and third year license fees and any associated fines are received by ABRA.


On November 6, 2015, the Respondent paid the license fees for the period of 2014 to 2015, and on November 20, 2015, the Respondent paid the license fees for the period of 2015 to 2016, and the associated late fees.

It is hereby **ORDERED**, that the **ORDERS TO CEASE AND DESIST** issued against Mahogany, LLC, t/a The Tap & Parlour/Bohemian Caverns, located at 2001 11th Street, N.W., Washington, D.C., by the Board on November 4 and November 18, 2015, pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), be and hereby are **VACATED**.



Pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-433(d)(1), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, 2000 14th Street, N.W., Suite 400S, Washington, DC 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code §2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 430 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001; (202/879-1010). However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR §1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
