

ORDER RESCINDING APPROVAL OF ABRA LICENSE NO. 092277


Ecelctico Concepts, LLC, t/a Tinto (Licensee), filed an Application for a Retailer's Class CT License (Application) at 3643 14th Street, N.W., which was approved under 23 DCMR § 405. Under § 405.1, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) may issue a license to an applicant that lacks a certificate of occupancy for the premises so long as the applicant satisfies the requirements of § 405.1. 23 DCMR § 405.1(b) (West Supp. 2015). Approval of an application under § 405.1 is conditioned on the Licensee paying the appropriate licensing fee. 23 DCMR § 405.4 (West Supp. 2015). In this case, the Licensee failed to pay its annual licensing fees; therefore, the licensee is not eligible for approval under § 405.1. Therefore, on this 9th day of December 2015, the Board **RESCINDS** approval of ABRA License Number 092277, held by the Licensee, and the license shall be deemed **CANCELLED**. A copy of this Order shall be delivered to the Licensee.



Pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008), any party adversely affected may file a Motion for Reconsideration of this decision within ten (10) days of service of this Order with the Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration, Reeves Center, 2000 14th Street, NW, 400S, Washington, D.C. 20009.

Also, pursuant to section 11 of the District of Columbia Administrative Procedure Act, Pub. L. 90-614, 82 Stat. 1209, D.C. Official Code § 2-510 (2001), and Rule 15 of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, any party adversely affected has the right to appeal this Order by filing a petition for review, within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this Order, with the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, 500 Indiana Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001. However, the timely filing of a Motion for Reconsideration pursuant to 23 DCMR § 1719.1 (2008) stays the time for filing a petition for review in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals until the Board rules on the motion. See D.C. App. Rule 15(b) (2004).
