**ORDER ON VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT AND
WITHDRAWAL OF ANC 5C'S PROTEST**

The Application filed by UW Liquors, Inc., t/a University Wine & Liquors, for renewal of its Retailer's Class A License, having been protested, came before the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) for a Roll Call Hearing on June 4, 2012, in accordance with D.C. Official Code § 25-601 (2001).

The Applicant and ANC 5C have entered into a Voluntary Agreement (Agreement), dated May 18, 2012, setting forth the terms and conditions that govern the operation of the Applicant's establishment.

The Agreement has been reduced to writing and has been properly executed and filed with the Board. The Applicant and Chairperson Ronnie L. Edwards and Commissioner Albrette "Gigi" Ransom, on behalf of ANC 5C, are signatories to the Agreement.

This Agreement constitutes a withdrawal of the Protest filed by ANC 5C of this Application.

Accordingly, it is this 27th day of June, 2012, **ORDERED** that:

1. The Application filed by UW Liquors, Inc., t/a University Wine & Liquors, for renewal of its Retailer's Class A License, located at 333 Hawaii Avenue, N.E., Washington, D.C., is **GRANTED**;
2. The Protest of ANC 5C in this matter is hereby **WITHDRAWN**;
3. The above-referenced Voluntary Agreements submitted by the parties to govern the operations of the Licensee's establishment is **APPROVED** and **INCORPORATED** as part of this Order, except for the following modifications:

The parties have agreed to these modifications.







University Wine and Liquors enters into this Voluntary Agreement and agrees to:

1. As required by law, will check the identification of each customer whose appearance fits the law's specified age range to assure the customer is allowed to purchase alcoholic beverages;
2. Assure the store's management and employees abide by federal laws by not charging a minimum purchase and a service fee for customers who make purchases using their debit cards (Dodd-Frank Act 2010*);
3. Extend lottery sale operations throughout their hours of operations especially for nighttime customers;
4. Abide by DC law by not selling or providing "Go-Cups" to customers; and,
5. Respect the diversity of its customers by speaking in English when non-Korean speaking customers are in the store or in their presence to show respect and to avoid potential conflict.
