2 PROTEST HEARING (STATUS)

3 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, the
4 next case on our protest hearing status is case
5 #16-PRO-00025, Village Whiskey, license #102077.

6 MR. FONSECA: Good morning members of the
7 Board, Michael Fonseca on behalf of the
8 applicant.

9 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning, Mr.
10 Fonseca.

11 MR. BENGEL: Good morning, Charlie Bengel
12 on behalf of ANC 2F. That's B as in boy, E-N-G-
13 E-L.

14 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Good morning, Mr.
15 Bengel. Are there any preliminary matters in
16 this case?

17 MR. FONSECA: No. We had mediation
18 yesterday. We've purposely delayed mediation
19 from the very beginning because we have a
20 singular issue of one hour for the roof terrace
21 and since the build-out hasn't even gotten to the
22 point where we've been able to satisfy the ANC on

1 our sound attenuation -- we're working on that --
2 so for two reasons we're not prepared to settle
3 yet, but we're also seeking if we can have the
4 July 13th protest moved to August 10th, so we can
5 get a sound engineer's report and settle this in
6 July.

7 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: All right, well
8 this matter is scheduled as you stated for a
9 protest hearing on July 13, 2016, at 1:30 and you
10 can contact the general counsel and if both
11 parties are -- if Mr. Behel?

12 MR. BENGEL: Bengel.

13 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: I wrote it down
14 and that's Mr. Bengel. What's your position on
15 this continuance?

16 MR. BENGEL: Oh, I'm in support.

17 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: So, you -- both
18 parties can connect our general counsel and come
19 up with a mutual agreeable date and as you heard
20 the instructions that were given regarding a
21 protest hearing, do you have any questions, sir?

22 MR. BENGEL: I do not.

1 CHAIRPERSON ANDERSON: Okay, all right,
2 so, unless the matter is continued then this
3 hearing is scheduled for July 13, 2016, at 1:30.
