**ORDER CANCELLING LICENSE**

The Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) has reviewed its records and determined that Sun-Mike, Inc., t/a Village Pantry, located at 3833 Pennsylvania Avenue, S.E., Washington, D.C., has failed to renew its License No. ABRA-074875, a Retailer's Class B License. Specifically, you failed to renew your license by September 30, 2011, the deadline for all Retailer's Class B licenses, despite being notified of the renewal date.


On December 14, 2011, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued an Order to Cease and Desist against Sun-Mike, Inc., t/a Village Pantry, located at 3833 Pennsylvania Avenue, S.E., Washington, D.C., pursuant to D.C. Official Code § 25-829 (2001), for failure to renew its Retailer's Class B License.






