**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND
REINSTATING LICENSE**

On July 27, 2011, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Order No. 2011-339, cancelling Young Won Trading, Inc.'s License No. ABRA-07887, because the establishment was out of business.


On March 20, 2012, Christian S. Choi, Young Won Trading, Inc.'s Executive Director, submitted a correspondence requesting to reinstate its License No. ABRA-07887, indicating that the Licensee did not receive any notice or any phone call concerning the license cancellation and the Board mistakenly determined that Young Won Trading, Inc. was out of business.

The Board finds that reconsideration is proper, because notice should have been provided to the Licensee before cancellation of the license.
