**ORDER VACATING CANCELLATION OF LICENSE AND  
REINSTATING LICENSE**

On May 28, 2014, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) issued Board Order No. 2014-232 cancelling the Retailer Class CX Multipurpose Facility License for Facility Concession Services, Inc., t/a Spectrum (Licensee). Specifically, the Licensee failed to pay the second year license fees for its License No. ABRA-087627 by March 31, 2014. *See* Board Order No. 2014-232.

On June 5, 2014, the Licensee paid the license fees for the period of 2014 to 2015 and the associated late fees.






